The 60th Anniversary year of NICE has given opportunity to reflect on all that God has been pleased to do through NICE and its missionaries over the years.

NICE Board Member, Pastor Charlie OI**son**, reflected, "Our church was pretty much an empty shell 30 years ago,

with a few women and children. These faithful women prayed that God would send men to lead the church. God did answer their prayers, and men, who had full time jobs, filled the pulpit and guided the growing congregation. They contacted NICE, and God led the Millers [Jim and Kathy

Miller] to serve as their Missionary Pastor. Under his leadership the church grew and became selfsupporting, and he also trained a new generation of men to serve as leaders."

Pastor Beau Floyd, of Emmaus Road Church, said, "I especially praise God that He has enabled us to reach people that other churches are not reaching. The further we reach into the

community and interact with people for the purpose of the Gospel, we see lives changed and the church growing. In the past year, we've seen 7 people confess their faith in Christ and be baptized. The church is a place of love and

grace, but also a place of truth. This results in the kind of environment where folks open up to Jesus to be transformed and begin to walk with Him."

"As I think about all that God has done at Seeley Lake, I especially praise God for His amazing grace," Pastor Rob Morris stated, thinking back on his ministry in Montana. He continued, "When we left I thought the church would probably close ... but now I see a church that

merged with a Village Missions ministry. A church that came together in unity, not a split, and a

brother who has returned to the Lord and is a key leader of this church. Many of my former church members have gone on to serve the Lord, some into the ministry. It's a thrill to see what God made of a struggling church, becoming a Lighthouse in a very dark place, reaching Seeley Lake with the Gospel!"
