Throughout its 63 years, the leaders of NICE have discovered great fulfillment and joy in training and mentoring men and women in the planting and establishing of churches. Many of those mentored have developed their ministry skills and become leaders for God's glory.

Such was true for Doug Nichols, the founder and Director of Action International Ministries. He recalled that "Henry Boyd, the first Director of NICE, provided training and experience for me in preaching, visitation, VBS, prison camps, and other ministry. That same in-depth training now continues through the Young Pastors Forum, a twice-a-month discussion Zoom meeting. NICE Director Bob Rodgers developed this in-depth Forum for the purpose of discussion, video teaching, dialogue and in-person presentation of Scriptural principles. All of these principles relate to the pastor and the local church – vital topics such as Preaching, Shepherding, Biblical Counseling, and Leadership Training. We now have 14 men as a regular part of our Forum."

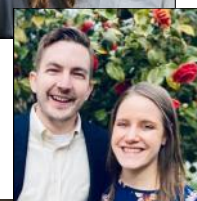
• **Matt Daniells**, Keyport Bible Church, said, "Great topics and ensuing discussions that I've found to be very helpful."
