
## 70 Years of Faithfulness

Bob Rodgers, NICE Executive Director, and his wife, Katherine were privileged to visit the first church that requested help of NICE after its founding. Loomis Community Church, Washington, was celebrating their 70th Anniversary on June 11. Individuals had begun meeting in 1889, and the church was incorporated as Loomis Community Church in 1953. Contact was made with Northwest Independent Church Extension in 1959, requesting help in finding a pastor. The Director at that time, Henry Boyd and his wife Margaret, responded to the need and came to serve the church as pastor. Bob was thrilled to see events come full circle, as he heard stories of the early days from visitor, Bill Gillette, Henry Boyd's grandson.

Bob gave a message on the 70th Anniversary Sunday, leading the congregation in "Celebrating Faithfulness". God's faithfulness was proclaimed with the key verse Psalm 89:1, "I will sing of the steadfast love of the Lord, forever; with my mouth I will make known Your faithfulness to all generations." The faithfulness of God's people was highlighted, mentioning how NICE

has served the church over the years through a number of its personnel: Bill and MaryJo Stoliker, Matt and Terri Sconce, Vern and Ann Fenton, Bob and Janice Haskell, and currently Keith and Claudia Singer.

Pastor Keith Singer challenged the church family to stand firm in proclaiming the Gospel message. He reflected later that one of the highlights of the day was the special music presented by several members of the



community meetings and contributed to the annual local Loomis meal. The church has been made available for many funerals over the years, as well as hosting a Vacation Bible School program each year. We also have several seasonal visitors who call this church their home, even though they

are only able to attend on a temporary basis. It has been exciting to see the Lord's great faithfulness at work in this church and its people!"
