Bob Rodgers added, "To assist in the process, we sought out Dave Deets, Vice President with Institute for Biblical Leadership, for guidance regarding the transition period. This gave us a direction in which to move forward and currently is what we are still using."

After much discussion, conversations, prayer and interviews, in April of this year, a call was extended to Robert and Bethany Zink, who readily accepted. At the beginning of the search process, the Board President was Bryan Austring, who reflected, "From the initial stages of our search, it has become increasingly clear that Robert is well equipped and uniquely gifted to serve on our staff, and to serve as our next Executive Director!" Charlie added, "In asking 'why Robert?', it was noted that he is recognized widely as a leader with organizational skills, he has broad contacts and a knowledge of the ministry of NICE. He has both missions and pastoral experience, and he is very inquisitive, always wanting to learn and grow.'
